

Characteristics of the facilities at the Montseny Biological Station

CENTRE OF FONTMARTINA:

- Location: https://goo.gl/maps/GRDyXEPhEU32
- Sleeps 14 in bunk beds in rooms of 4 people.
- Users must bring their own sleeping bags or bed linen, pillowcase, towels and personal hygiene products.
- Kitchen with capacity for 18 people maximum.
- The kitchen has stoves, fridge, microwave oven, toaster, italian coffee maker, glasses, cutlery and all necessary kitchenware (pots, pans, etc.). You must leave them clean on departure.
- Users must bring their own food. There is salt, sugar and olive oil.
- Toilets, showers and hot water.
- Locally and remotely adjustable heating.
- Room for courses or presentations (capacity 30 people) with projector and screen.
- Room for meetings/work.
- Internet access.
- First-aid kit.
- Torch, basic tools, candles, matches and other material in locker 1 in entrance hall.
- Driving time from Sant Celoni: 25 minutes.

There isn't any food store, bakery or other services before Sant Celoni. The nearest restaurant with reasonable prices is 15-20 minutes away. For week-end residential courses, we recommend to bring your food for all meals.

Instructions and general rules of the centre:

You do not need to touch any switch on from the switch box at the entrance hall. Do not switch off electricity on departure.

The person in charge of the key must lock the doors of the building and the fence when you are not in the centre.

Dogs or other pets are not allowed.

Vehicles must park behind the house.

No smoking allowed inside the building and kitchen.

Keep the house clean and tidy. You will find cleaning products and toilet paper in the closet.

Separate your waste and use the collection point at the entrance road.

Leave the books of the library in their place.



CENTRE OF EL PUIG:

- Sleeps 12 in bunk beds in rooms of 4 people.
- Users must bring their own sleeping bags or bed linen, pillowcase, towels and personal hygiene products.
- Basic kitchen with capacity of around 8 people maximum.
- The kitchen has stoves, fridge, microwave oven, toaster, glasses, cutlery and all necessary kitchenware (pots, pans, etc.). You must leave then clean on departure
- Toilets, showers and hot water.
- Adjustable heating.
- Tables, plugs and space for working for 12 people maximum.
- No Internet access.
- No signal for most telephone operators.
- First-aid kit.
- Driving time from Sant Celoni: 50 minutes / from Viladrau: 15 minutes.

There are food stores, bakeries and services in Viladrau. There is a restaurant nearby (5 min. on foot) but it is not always open on working days.

<u>Instructions and general rules of the centre:</u>

IMPORTANT: you must turn electricity on by raising the switch (labeled) in the switch box in the first floor. You must turn electricity off on exit.

The thermostat of the heating is on the ground floor, outside the boiler room. You must fill the boiler with pellet bags to keep the heating working.

Tap water is available after 30 minutes of turning electricity on.

The person in charge of the key must lock the doors of the building and the chain when you are not in the centre.

Dogs or other pets are not allowed.

Vehicles must park in the open area before crossing the chain.

No smoking allowed inside the building and kitchen.

Keep the house clean and tidy. You will find cleaning products and toilet paper in the closet.

Separate your waste and use the collection point at the entrance road.
